ExxonMobil Link Schools Programme

A collaboration between CREATE and ExxonMobil to support curriculum projects and the introduction of energy efficiency measures in schools located close to ExxonMobil - Esso facilities.

Project partners include:

ExxonMobil, CREATE, Groundwork Trust, Scotland Forward, Local Authority Energy Management Units and 25 schools in Aberdeen, Aberdeenshire, Fife and Surrey.

CREATE offers a range of services to schools designed to support them in developing a whole school approach to energy management, improving their energy efficiency and delivering quality education projects.

To date the programme has included:

- Training for Head Teachers and Site Supervisors on school energy management
- Training for Class Teachers on energy in the curriculum
- Support for rebate applications under the SchoolEnergy Programme
- Delivery sessions with young people in primary and secondary schools
- Interactive support materials

The programme has been highly successful in establishing energy management and sustainability as key resourcing and curriculum issues in the participating schools. In addition to developing quality curriculum projects, energy efficiency benefits include:

- Participating schools that have applied for rebates under the SchoolEnergy Programme have benefited from over £60,000 of investment in energy efficiency measures.
- On average, each school has achieved annual savings on energy bills of £3,800.
- Measures installed include; draught proofing, insulation, reflective radiator panels, thermostatic radiator valves, low energy lighting and fridge/freezer controls.
